As outlined in the Children (NI) Order 1995, Guidance and Regulations Volume 3, Family Placement and Private Fostering sections 4.50, 4.55 and 5.18, financial arrangements are discussed with foster carers during the assessment as well as in the written agreement between the Trust and foster carer.

A service level agreement is completed between the Trust and foster carer when a fee is paid. They also undertake a yearly review regarding the fee grade they are receiving.
