What is Supported Employment?



Some service users will get a job through the Day Opportunities programme. This is called Supported Employment.

This means that they work in a job where someone can help them to learn new skills.



The Day Opportunities Coordinator will find out what the service user likes and doesn't like to do.

The Supported Employment Service will look at what jobs the service user would be able to do.



There are lots of different jobs like working in a café, a supermarket, a warehouse or a nursery.



Someone will be there to help the service user at work



The Day Opportunities Coordinator will continue to meet with the service user to make sure that everything is going OK and that this is the right service for them
