IF YOU HAVE BEEN BEREAVED BY SUICIDE

Suicide has such a traumatic and devastating impact on families and communities.

Dealing with a bereavement through suicide is challenging due to the range and depth of emotions experienced - often accompanied by questions as to 'why' it has happened.

We know that the days and weeks to come will be very difficult, but you do not have to face them alone. There is support, help and information available.

The Bereaved by Suicide Service provides 1-1 therapeutic sessions, bereaved by suicide support groups and events throughout the year.

These sessions are currently available throughout the Northern Trust area, and a fixed number of sessions per person are free through this service.

You are eligible for support if:

You have been bereaved by suicide (bereavement support is most useful when the person has had time to experience natural grieving processes).

You are aged 18 years or older.

You are a resident within the Northern Health and Social Care Trust area which includes the District Council areas of Antrim, Ballymena, Ballymoney, Ballycastle, Carrickfergus, Coleraine, Cookstown, Larne, Magherafelt, Newtownabbey.

If you would like more information about a support group in your area, or to be referred for individual support sessions, please contact the Bereaved by Suicide Support Officer who will complete your referral. Details are overleaf.
