I'm reaching out because I'd be interested in finding out up to date information on the estimated waiting time for an NHS breast screening appointment for GP referrals and for age 50-70 rolling appointments / how many people are now waiting for a screening appointment for a potential article.

I can only find the quarterly statistics online, related to cancer wait times for treatments and can't seem to find any stats tied to breast cancer screenings specifically. I'm not sure if you have access to this information and would be willing to share it, or could point me to someone who might be able to help.

Breast screening doesn't have a waiting list as such. Women are invited to attend every 3 years once they reach the age of 50 which is carried out by locality.
