

## **Freedom of Information Request**

- I'm aware that on 05 June 2020, Health Minister Robin Swann announced a £11.7M financial support package in additional funding for Northern Ireland's Care Homes, to help them meet the challenge of the pandemic.
- I received confirmation from the DOH in Jan 2021 this year to advise that the Trusts hold this information in terms of what was awarded to the Care Homes.
- We know that this additional financial support made available by the Trusts to Care Homes included improved access to PPE; enhanced cleaning regimes; wrap-around support/mutual aid from HSC Trust colleagues; protocols to reduce footfall in the homes; IPC training for all staff; provision of additional equipment to support care and contact with family members etc.
- Please furnish me with the :-
  - A. Names of all the Care Homes who received funding within your Trust area from this £11.7M.
  - B. Name of the Health Care Group (if applicable).
  - C. The value of the Funding awarded to each Care Home within your Trust area.
  - D. Award Date of the Funding provided to each Care Home within your Trust area.
  - E. Did the Care Home have to apply for this funding (Yes or No, and if Yes, the Date the Care Home applied for the funding package and the Criteria used to make this award).
